

We Can Secure Our World Animation: Phishing, Audio Description

Max, his grandma Michelle, Joan the phone, and Tommy the Tablet are all enjoying the beach, singing, “We can secure our world!”

Max says, “Time for fun in the sun!” Michelle looks at her smart watch and exclaims, “Oh no! I just got a text from my bank. I need to confirm my account immediately!” Joan approaches and says, “Hold on there, that may be phishing.” The word **PHISHING** appears in the sky.

Joan sings, “When you get a message, think it through.” A grinning shark leaps from the ocean saying, “Free vacation!” Joan sings, “Could someone want to take advantage of you?” As she sings, seagulls try to steal Michelle’s beach bag and Max shouts, “Watch out!”

Close up on Joan singing, “If it’s urgent or amazing, well it could be a trick. Recognize and think before you click.” **RECOGNIZE** appears and we cut to Tommy who is riding a wave on a surfboard and shouts, “Don’t fall for it, dude!” Max’s grandpa Mark appears in a canoe in the ocean, and everyone sings, “We can secure our world.”

Joan sings, “If there’s a link or an attachment, think twice. Might be a scam to hack your device.” A crab grabs at her hand, and she throws it toward the ocean. It soars past Tommy as he surfs by and shouts, “Woohoo! Wipeout!” as it splashes down.

Cut to a school of fish swimming up to a fishhook baited with money while Joan sings, “If they ask you for your info, you just say, ‘No way!’ Report it and delete it and get on with your day.” **REPORT** and **DELETE** appear as the fishing hook flies away and Tommy shouts, “Right on!”

Everyone stands on the beach singing, “When you think it’s phishing, pause for just a beat, then remember three steps, recognize, report, delete! That’s how we can secure our world!”
