


# NATIONAL INTEROPERABILITY FIELD OPERATIONS GUIDE (NIFOG) VERSION 2.02



The NIFOG has been updated to version 2.02. The NIFOG is a technical reference for radio technicians, used for emergency communications planning and disaster response. The NIFOG includes rules and regulations for use of nationwide and other interoperability channels, tables of frequencies and standard channel names, and other reference material, formatted as a pocket-sized guide for radio technicians to carry with them.

The electronic National Interoperable Field Operations Guide version 2.02 is now available as part of the Public Safety Library (PS mobile app on Apple® iOS™ and Google® Android™ devices.)

#### Easy to Use

Being an integral part of the Public Safety Library app, the eNIFOG allows users easy access to the information, providing a content index with shortcuts to reference materials, sections, tables, figures, and images.

Navigation links allow users to reach regional quick references, as well as bookmark favorites to develop their own personalized view of critical information within their territory. eNIFOG can be downloaded and used as an offline reference without the need of cellular or data connection.
