Instructor-Led Training (ILT) delivered by subject matter experts in a traditional classroom setting at your location

Online

Virtual Instructor-Led Training (VILT)

Online training with a live instructor

Independent Study Training (IST)

Easily accessible, self-paced, web-based

Micro Training Videos (MTVs)

Short instructional videos that communicate the threat, explain C-IED concepts, demonstrate bombing prevention procedures and identifying suspicious activity

Train-the-Trainer

Empowered Trainer Program (ETP)

Trains federal, state, local, tribal, territorial and private sector trainers to teach accredited OBP training curricula to their local audiences
